

# New COVID-19 Guidelines for Summer Camps

Following new guidance from the Government of New Brunswick, your children are no longer restricted to specific set groups and will be allowed to intermingle. We ask parents and guardians to be aware that their actions play a critical role in reducing the risk of infectious disease transmission in the facilities. We ask any adults in contact with any children attending our summer day camp to be monitoring for symptoms and arrange for testing immediately if they develop two more symptoms.

We encourage that only one parent or guardian per family be responsible for the drop-off and pick-up of the child or children at our day camp.

Parents/guardians are responsible for reviewing the screening questions daily with their children and only sending their child to camp when they are well and have met the criteria outline in the screening questionnaire. The screening questionnaire can be found on the backside of this sheet.

Below is the parental confirmation form. It needs to be signed by the child's parent/guardian to indicate that you will conduct daily screening.

# ATTENTION



If you answer **'YES'** to any of the following questions, **DO NOT ENTER** this building. Please return home and self-isolate.

- Do you have **TWO (2)** of the following symptoms that are not related to a known pre-existing health condition (i.e., seasonal allergies)? If **YES**, you should be tested for COVID-19.



Fever



Cough (or worsening cough)



Diarrhea



Loss of sense of smell and taste



In children, purple markings on the fingers and toes



Runny nose



Sore throat



Muscle pain



Headache



Fatigue/ exhaustion

- Have you been advised by Public Health, a health-care provider, travel registry, or a peace officer that you are currently required to isolate?
- Are you waiting for a COVID-19 test or COVID-19 test results AND have been told you need to isolate?
- Have you travelled outside of the Atlantic Travel Bubble (which includes Avignon and Témiscouata) in the past 14 days? (This question does not apply if you are exempt from isolation because you have received at least 1 dose of the vaccine or because you tested negative on day 5-7 of your isolation).
- Have you travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days? (This question does not apply if you are exempt from current provincial and federal isolation requirements).

If you answered **'NO'** to the above questions, **YOU MAY ENTER** the facility.

If you are experiencing any symptoms, you should get tested. You can register for a test online by clicking 'Get tested' on the GNB Coronavirus website, calling Tele-Care 811 or by contacting your primary health-care provider.
